7. HANGING THE PARTITIONS:


7a. While looking at your plans, start on one end of your closet and place the first Partition next to the wall. Pull the Partition down tight to secure as shown in figure 1.

7b. With a tape measure and pencil mark on the wedgerail the location of the next partition (dimension of shelf) as show in figure 1. Attach next Partition and secure.


*Note: If you have Back Panels do step 8a and 8b first before continuing.


Ac. Place (2) EQ clips in the top holes on each Partition as show in figure 2.

7d. Place the correct size shelf over the (4) EQ clips and pull down firmly as show in figure



e. Repeat steps 7b-7d for each Partition until all Partitions are in place as shown in figure 4




10. ATTACHING F-RAIL TO SHELF:

10a. Shelf over 30" comes with a F-Rail for support. Attach to the back with a rubber hammer as shown in figure 1




SHOE SHELVES & HANGING RODS

13. SHOE SHELVES:

13a Shoe Shelves install just like regular shelves. Shoe shelves can also be installed at a angle by lowering the front (2) EQ clips down two holes as shown in figure 1.




3b. Shoe Rails are sent not installed. To install shoe rails insert pegs into holes in the front of the shoe shelf pressing firmly as shown in figure 2.




14. HANGING RODS:

14a. Hanging Rods have two parts the Rod and the Rod Ends. First install the Rod Ends into desired hole location as shown in figure 3.


15. DRAWER SLIDES:

16. DRILL DRAWER FACE :


16a. Drawer faces have pilot holes for standard size Drawer Handles. Determine the correct pilot hole for your handle and **carefully** drill remaining material with a sharp 3/16" Drill Bit as shown in figure 1.





BASKETS


20. BASKET ASSEMBLY:

- 20a. Position ball bearing slide where desired in closet
- 20b. Align slide holes with Partition holes as shown in Figure 1 & 2. Using the screws sent with basket attach the slide to the Partition
- 20c. Position and install other slide.
- 20d. Place back wire of basket into hook on left and right slide as shown in Figure 3.
- 20e. Pivot the basket down so that the tabs on the basket are inserted into the slots in the slides as show in Figure 4.





21. PANT RACK INSTALLATION:




IRONING BOARD

22. IRONING BOARD INSTALLATION:


22a. Separate inner slide from outer slide, by extending them fully, depressing the plastic release lever, and pulling apart from the remainder of the slide assembly as shown in figure 1.

22b. Attach the Ball Bearing part of the slide to the desired location on the partition as your design shows using the screws sent with the Ironing Board as shown in figure 2.




22c. Using the 5mm Allen wrench, and 10mm wrench, remove the board and front support from the friction slide units as shown in figure 3.



22d. Once the ironing board, and front support is remove Re-assemble the slides as shown in figure 4.



22f. Attach Drawer Handle to Drawer Face using the pre-drilled pilot holes as shown in figure 6.



22h. You can now carefully pull on the Drawer Handle to open the Drawer "Slightly" to have access to screw in the Drawer Face. Using (8) provided #8 flathead screws, screw in the face to the slides as shown in figure 8.



22i. With Drawer front attached re-install the board, support brackets, and nechanism into the drawer being sure to have the front wire support held n place on the drawer front by the support brackets as shown in figure 9.

22j. Use (4) #8 flathead screws to attach the support bracket to the drawer front as shown in figure 10.




23. CBSR-14, CTR-14, AND CVR-14




23b. Loosen the 4mm set screws on the Mounting Posts with supplied hex key as shown in figure 2.



23c. Insert the slide assembly to the desired location and tighten the 4mm set screws with supplies hex key as shown in figure 3 & 4.






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
DOORS

25. DOOR ASSEMBLY:

25a. Laying the Door on a flat surface and with the flap up, push the door hinges into the holes as shown in figure 1.




25c. Line up Door with Hinges attached to Partition to locate holes where Inserta Plates will be installed as shown in figure 3




25e. Fold flaps down to secure Inserta Plate to Partition as sown in figure 5. Repeat for other Inserta Plate.




25b. Push Flap down to secure Door Hinges to Door as shown in figure 2.




25d. Push Inserta Plate into holes located in step 25c. with flaps up and arrows facing front of unit as shown in figure 4.



25f. Attach Door by sliding Door Hinges into groove of the Inserta Plate and Push down on Hinge to snap in place as shown in figure 6.



25g. Adjust screws for best fit of Door as shown in figure 7.






28b. Referring to your Design install all shelves using (6) EQ Clips per shelf as shown in figure 5




29. BRACE INSTALLATION:



29b. Insert 19mm Outrigger to both ends of Brace as shown in figure 2.




29c. Slide Brace under and then up into RTA Screw Dowel as shown in figure 3.






31d. Follow step 7 for installing Partition and then adjust Partition foot by turning ound plastic at base of the foot to level Partition as shown in figure 5.



Note: Partition Feet only come with 24" deep Partitions.





34. TOE -KICK CORNER INSTALLATION:


34a. Place corner shelf on a flat surface, Screw in the (3)RTA Dowels into the bottom front holes as shown in figure 3.




33b. Side Toe-Kicks come cut to length and ready to install. Using Grooves on Side Toe-Kick snap into place over Baseboard Clip adjusting to be flush with end of front Toe-Kick as shown in figure 2.

34b. Attach the (3)19mm Outriggers to the pre-cut Corner Toe-Kick as shown in figure 4.






TOP MOLDING


35. TOP MOLDING INSTALLATION:

35a. Refer to your Design and measure desired length of each Top Molding as shown in the 3 typical designs




35b. Top molding comes in 8', and 4' sizes and is edgebanded on one side. Cut each Part with Hand saw or recommended Circular Saw.

35c. Attach Top Molding with 1-1/4" screw every 12" using the pre-drilled holes as shown in figure 2.




TROUBLE SHOOTING

PICKING THE RIGHT SCREW FOR YOUR WEDGERAIL:



How to Shim your Wedgerail:

A. Using a straight edge like a Partition or long Level tool, run it along the wall until you see a gap between straight edge and wall. Loosen the screws in wedgerail around that location and insert two shims as shown in figure 1. Position Shims on top of each other behind wedgerail so wedgerail is lifted equally from top to bottom as shown in figure 2. Hammer shims in equally until face of wedgerail is level and then snap shims off and re-screw wedgerail in as shown in figure 3.
